ARE YOU READY FOR A CHANGE?

You might have missed attending Transfair, or you went and interviewed but didn't receive an offer to change schools. Is it the end of the search for you? No, it isn't. In fact, many instructional changes do not occur as a result of Transfair. Continue to stay active with calls and resumes. Destaffed teachers will be placed first, but that is usually accomplished by July 1. You should check the Vacancy List daily since it is frequently updated with new openings. Go to www.fcps.edu. On the main page, click A-Z index. Then go to "V" for Vacancies. Many teachers move out of state in the summer or retire, and new positions occur unexpectedly.

Before you interview at another school, be sure to read about the

school on the web. You need to familiarize yourself with the school's profile, mission statement, and test scores. You will want to be knowledgeable, informed, and prepared. And, don't forget to dress appropriately and smile.

Remember that any teaching transfer should occur by July 31, 2013. After that date, you will need both principals' permission to make a change.

actual knowledge that an employee" is in violation of the regulation has responsibilities, which include submitting that employee for a screening test. Do not put yourself in a vulnerable position. Do not put yourself, your students and /or your colleagues at risk.

Any rebuttal to the final evaluation should be submitted before June 30. If you do not agree with your final evaluation, you may write a rebuttal. Please have one of our FCFT staff help you compose one. Rebuttals will be attached to your final evaluation and placed in your file.

All final evaluations must be signed.
