SAFE DRIVING

All of us are seeing road workers now repairing pot holes and patching up roadways. The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) reminds drivers to be very cautious while driving near the workers. Last year there were ten fatalities in Northern VA that occurred in the work areas. The state saw more than 4000 auto crashes in

road-work areas also. The workers are out patching from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. weekdays and occasionally at other times. Drive slowly through the areas. So far the workers have patched up over 10,000 potholes and will continue through the spring. If you want to report a pot hole, call VDOT Customer Service at 800-367-7623.

KEEP TWENTY DAYS.



FCFT advises our members to keep twenty days of sick leave in their accounts, just in case something happens for which short-term disability (STD) would be needed. Before short-term disability begins, there is a twenty-day elimination-period. This means, days one through twenty will

be your sick leave days. Day twentyone will begin short-term disability.

If an employee does not have twenty days of sick leave, those days will become leave without pay.
